## LICENSE RENEWAL 2016-17

At the September 30, 2016 meeting of the Provincial Dental Board, the Board approved the 2017 Budget which will see a 3% increase in licensing fees. The Board also approved a Temporary Authorization Renewal form which can be used by dentists who currently hold a Temporary Authorization and wish to renew it in 2016-17. The policy on Temporary Authorization and the application form for Temporary Authorization can be found on the Provincial Dental Board website: [www.pdbns.ca](http://www.pdbns.ca). Renewal forms will be sent out to those who currently hold a Temporary Authorization. Dentists applying for or renewing a Temporary Authorization are required to pay a fee of \$64.00.

The licensing fees for 2016-17 are:

The 2016-17 license renewal forms will soon be mailed to dentists. This year's form has new questions on radiography, sedation, human allograft and incorporations. The document must be completed fully, signed by the dentist and payment remitted by 4:30pm on November 30, 2016. A failure to do so will result in a being struck from the Dental Register and a reinstatement fee of \$556.00 charged in addition to the licensing fee.
